Australian Selection

As you know, I took over the Records in July. It took some time to
 bring same up to date and many discrepancies had to be overlooked
 owing to the time lapse. However, I would like to make some comments
 which, after discussion and review, may make the new Record's
 Secretary's task so much easier.

- Fixture Cards: One the whole, these are disgraceful. Quite
 often, only the Club name appears on top section - no distinction
 as to Grade, team number, opponent or date.
 It takes quite some time to decipher team personnel when apart
 from handwriting, blunt or faint pencils are used or a card is
 made out too early and numerous changes are necessary.
 Umpires here often contribute to the chaos by entering different
 results or on other occasions, no result is listed and entries
 on the back do not tally with the other umpire.
- Players playing in higher grades: I do feel the rules need
 reviewing in respect of the number of times a player plays in a
 higher grade and also the number who may be promoted from a
 lower or lower teams to allow a higher team to be fielded.
 This is difficult to word and perhaps for you to understand, but
 it refers mainly to the larger clubs who obtain a distinct
 advantage over the smaller Clubs.
