## REPORT FROM THE MANAGEMENT MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY 11<sup>th</sup> JULY, 2017.

1. **BWHA COUNCIL MEETING: Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> JULY at 7.00pm** at the BWHA Clubhouse, Downey Park. At this meeting we will discuss the **Representative Process, items like:**
  - What can BWHA do to encourage more nominations for Selectors, Coaches, Managers, Umpires;
  - What is our process if we do not get enough nominations;
  - Players:
    - The role of Development programs
    - Rep Team Trials: how players are placed in groups for trials
    - Use of fixtures for selection
    - Use of SX for selection
    - Parents coaching their own daughters in rep teams
  
2. **GRANTS CURRENTLY OPEN:**
  - a. BCC Funding: **closes 23/10/17**
    - Community Facility Maintenance - \$100,000
    - Community Facility Development - \$100,000
    - Organisational Development - \$7,500
  - b. State Government: **closes 11/8/17**
    - Get Going Places & Spaces - \$150,000
    - Get Going Clubs – Participation Opportunities - \$7500 – would encourage all clubs to apply for at least this money for umpire development.
  
3. **UMPIRES & TECHNICAL**
  - a. The Umpires online Rules Paper **will not** be held this year, we hope to have all the technical issues resolved so we can have a paper ready for the start of the 2018 season.
  - b. A reminder to clubs that club officials are not to approach the umpire after the game with concerns/complaints, concerns are to be either written on the back of the match sheet (and signed) or an official complaint emailed in from the club, this includes officials from the same club as the umpire.
  - c. Shoot-out Rules for Senior Finals – these have been updated and are attached, the only changes are in regard to the control & location for grass finals.
  - d. **Reminder of Ops Manual Rule: 23 Finals**
    - (1) No player shall take part in the semi-finals and finals unless having been registered and played at least six (6) fixture games in each of six (6) separate sets of fixture rounds for the relevant fixture section (senior grass, senior turf, masters or juniors) with their club during the season.

#### 4. CHANGE OF REGISTRATIONS

The last day for moving players down a division has now passed (11/7/17). Players Registration type can continue to change eg Cas5 to Cas10, but you can no longer move a player down a division eg Div 1 to Div2.

#### 5. CLUBHOUSE

#### 6. OPERATIONS MANUAL RULES UPDATES:

The following changes to the Finals rules have been made – they make no material difference to the rules, only condensing 4 rules to 1 as we no longer play extra time.

*Rule 23. Finals – changes July 2017*

(3) If at full time a Senior (**Turf, Grass, Masters**) Final (**semi, preliminary, grand**) is drawn, the game winner will be decided in accordance with FIH rules. This rule doesn't apply to a game to which rule 23 (2) applies.

~~(4) If at full time a Masters semi-final is drawn, the game winner will be decided in accordance with FIH rules. This rule doesn't apply to a game to which rule 23 (2) applies.~~

~~(6) If at full time the Senior final is drawn, the game will be decided in accordance with FIH rules. This rule doesn't apply to a game to which rule 23 (2) applies.~~

~~(7) If at full time the Masters final is drawn, a winner will be decided in accordance with rule 23(6) with any extra time adjusted in accordance with the reduced game time played in the Masters competition.~~

#### 7. JUNIORS

- a. The JT1 game cancelled due to the fog at SHC on the 07.07.17 will be played at BP on the 22<sup>nd</sup> July at 6.00pm.(after the Div 1 games)
- b. U11A/B will split into 2 divisions of 6 teams on the 22<sup>nd</sup> July, then play through to sudden death finals.
- c. U7 & U9 Carnival planned for the 19<sup>th</sup> August (instead of a final fixture).
