## PRESIDENT'S REPORT

An annual report is always an opportunity to reflect on the many achievements, successes and challenges that we have faced throughout the year, and it gives me much pleasure to be able to highlight some of these in this report.

Once again we can be proud of our many achievements during the year:

- Ran hockey fixture competitions for juniors, seniors and masters, on turf and on grass, for over 3000 registered players. Fortunately this year the weather was kind to us and fixtures ran without a hitch.
- Won Division 1 age division at State Championships in 2010: Premier League, Open, U15, U13 and Veterans. Coming second in the U18's and winning the Under 11 Division 1 Southern Cross.
- Worked with Brisbane Hockey Association (BHA) and Kedron Wavell Services Hockey Club (KWSHC) to consolidate the Brisbane Hockey Management Group (BHMG) which was established to run the Burringbar Turf Facility after the collapse of ShawSportz. This year we have demonstrated that the facility is financially viable and can generate enough funds to cover both running costs and provide a sinking fund for turf replacement.
- Telecast of Division 1 Hockey through QCTV each week, in conjunction with BHA. This year saw the introduction of commentators from each club and what a difference it makes when local detail is introduced into commentary.

Areas for us to focus on in the next year include:

- Planning for a turf surface at Downey Park, together with upgrading storage and toilet facilities.
- Greater promotion of the benefits of QCTV coverage. We have not exploited the potential sponsorship capabilities of this medium nor looked at greater use of the telecasts for ongoing coaching of players, coaches, umpires and commentators.
- Upgrade of the turf at Burringbar Park in conjunction with BHA and KWSHC. We currently have two grant applications in the pipeline with the State Government and Brisbane City Council for funding to help cover the cost of this turf upgrade.
- Volunteer management – the number of people prepared and able to commit to the many volunteer duties needed to run our organisation seems to dwindle every year. Even when paid positions are offered it is often still difficult to fill them. As is the case for many other similar organisations, we need to review what roles and responsibilities are essential and how best to address them.

In spite of the occasional challenges and difficulties we can be very proud of our achievements. In closing I would particularly like to thank all the members of my management committee for their efforts, consideration, and good humour. To our dedicated volunteers – thank you, because without you we would not be able to exist. And last but not least my sincere thanks to Kath Proctor and all the BWHA staff for their ongoing support and hard work.

## SECRETARY'S REPORT

Welcome to the 2010 Annual Report. I am pleased to report (touch wood) that 2010 was a little less stressful than 2009. While the effects of the two floods in 2009 have still been felt in 2010, we did not have to evacuate again.

After the problems in 2009 it was decided to make a permanent move from under the clubhouse to the dance floor area of the 1<sup>st</sup> floor. I would like to thank Shane Bradnoch from Kennington Homes and John Bowkett's Electrical for doing most of the work during the Christmas break which allowed us to return to work at the beginning of this year in a clean, fresh, and air conditioned facility. We still have a number of small items to finalise, but it has been a pleasure working in this new area. Thank you Shane and "Ringo" for all your work, assistance and patience – it was greatly appreciated. This move provided an opportunity for Just Hockey to trial using the former BWA offices under the clubhouse for their pro-shop. A decision will be made soon to determine if this will remain the best place for Just Hockey to be situated at DP.

BWA planning took place in October to December of 2009, making the base for our 2010 season. It was great to welcome Kathryn Duggan permanently to our team after she has worked under contract for 6 months when Elle left. Kathryn looked after the Summer Competition with Jenny Heron and updated all forms and calendars ready for season 2010. Kathryn's role also involved the reception, turf bookings, working closely with Annette Stouter on events and many other administrative roles in the office.

During planning it was decided to bring the database recording of Match Statistics back into the office. Clubs would remain responsible for entering members and full membership details, but the importance of having accurate match statistics was determined worthy of a casual person to look after this. In March 2010 Chris Carr joined our small team and proved invaluable in this role. Thank you to all clubs for their hard work in keeping the membership part of the database up to date. It is still undecided if we will continue with this system as it seems to lurch from one problem to another with no guarantee of it ever being able to meet our sports requirements.

The season appeared to start quite smoothly, but soon we lost a couple of people from our Management Committee. Karen Hickling organised all the Match Secretary's work in an easy to use excel system which took a significant amount of work. Unfortunately Karen then left to pursue other priorities. Michele Slater offered to take over this position. We hope Michele enjoyed this challenge. Karen continued to assist the office throughout the season when asked, this is the beauty of email, Karen's assistance with the Budgets and Fees Spreadsheet has been invaluable.

Desley Mackay also stood down from Management after many years of service as the Junior Chairperson and on Senior Management. While not on Management, Desley continues to play a large role in hockey through her efforts in the development area. Annette Stouter took over some of the roles in Desley's absence and with the support of the office powered through a lot of work, including the QCTV, Dinners and Finals. Annette has decided not to renominate for the Events portfolio on Management, but has offered to work in a significant project behind the scenes, which has been gratefully accepted by Management.

Meg Brodie who had been our Treasurer, after discussions with Sonya Fisher our Vice President, it appeared to make better use of their relative expertise to swap portfolios with Meg moving to Facilities and Sonya to Treasurer. Meg is available during office hours to liaise with John our Groundsman and as she is involved in Downey Park fixtures this was a better match. Sonya who has 25 years experience in the banking sector is now the BWA Treasurer.

We again worked very closely with BHA throughout the season. Jenny Heron working with Barry Bolton from BHA organised the joint shared usage of the available turfs in Brisbane for fixtures. With the new Easts Tiger Turf online, this added another facility that had to be utilised in an efficient manner. The EHTT facility is a credit to Easts Hockey Club and reports have been favourable from players. Unfortunately as Easts came online, we saw the rapid deterioration of the BP turf. The BHMG worked throughout the year looking at ways to provide an upgraded surface in 2011. Grant applications have been submitted and it is cross your finger time, for without a new surface the BP turf will be unplayable in 2011. Thank you to all Fixture and Grading committees for your hard work in 2010.

The SHC was heavily used this year for State level competition which has a major impact on our fixtures. The National U21's in July and then the men's AHL finals in August meant BHA delayed their season by a week and therefore no joint turf grand finals were held. On the positive side the 5 divisions of women's hockey enjoyed all playing on the Saturday together, but the atmosphere was a little quieter without the men's turf finals being played at the same time. Management will decide if they want to return to a joint grand final in the future. This delay also caused some problems with the joint turf dinner; however the venue and awards were great at the Chifley this year. Again a decision needs to be made on whether our

members really want a dinner to recognise their season. We are in a changing world and what was once a very prestigious event may no longer be relevant to our current turf players.

Our representative teams again were very successful at all levels. We are lucky to have such a great Development Team of Sharyn, Sue & Regie creating opportunities for our player and coach development. It takes much organisation and planning to allow so many people to be involved at representative levels, so congratulations to our Development Team for a job well done. Thank you to all selectors, who give up many hours watching fixtures and trials to select the best teams possible, and to our volunteer coaches, managers and umpires who travel with the teams. Full details of the results follow in this report.

In 2010 we hosted the State U18 Tournament at the SHC. Hockey Queensland appointed Ronda Nix as the Tournament Director and Helen Sharp was appointed the BWA Championship Convenor. With Ronda's leadership and Helen's wonderful organisational skills the tournament ran well and for a change rain did not interrupt the tournament. Well done to all workers, supporters and team personnel.

Umpiring! What everyone loves to hate. Many hours of planning, development and training happen each year, but it continues to be an area of great challenge. The situation can only improve with everyone's involvement: supporters, officials, players and the umpires themselves. We can't have a game without them, so we need to stand united to support them. Thank you to Lesley Bennett and Sonya Fisher for their tireless efforts in this area and to the Umpires and Technical Committee who constantly strive for improvement across this area of our sport. Thank you to our Mentors in particular Jan Hadfield whose assistance and guidance is always appreciated.

Our Junior Committee continue to do a great job, organising and providing quality hockey for children aged 4+ to 17. Debbie Wark and her committee should be proud of all they achieve each year. In 2010 an additional division moved to turf. Boys played their U11 Coulter Shield with the U11 Southern Cross at Downey Park. This was a great day and ran very smoothly through the efforts of the Junior and Development Committees. The Junior Section of this report highlights the many achievements of our Junior Committee.

Chris Blanchard and Melda Dunning joined Management for the first time this year. Chris's expertise in governance and procedures saw her talents being fully utilised in her first year. Chris with a few members of Management completed a Risk Register and she is currently working with the Constitution Committee to rewrite the By-Laws, Local Rules, Policies and Procedures into one "plain English" Operations Manual. Melda took on the long neglected area of Sports Trainers, bringing some new initiatives to streamline this area of our sport. Well done to both our new Management people, we look forward to a long and exciting involvement.

Joyce Proctor, Elma Brennand and Shirley Otto spent countless hours working through our archives. They hope to have a detailed list and report of all information held in the near future. Thank you for all your work in this area. Karin, Jenny T, Joyce, Caroline, Bud, Mary, Rhonda all assisted at Downey Park, either in the Canteen, Bar, Uniforms or Control Room, we have truly great volunteers. Thank you to Mary and Bev for opening and closing the clubhouse when private functions have been held, your assistance is much appreciated. Kristin (Canteen) and Denise (Bar) continued to provide quality service and goods to our members each Saturday, thank you for all your hard work. To our many casual workers on Saturday, thank you. A special thanks to Charli in the Saturday Office and Sharon her mum who filled in when Charli was not available.

In 2009 our Life Member and very good friend – Dr Mary Hughes passed away. In her will she left a bequest of \$50,000.00 to BWA. This money when received will be used to provide shade shelters near Fields 1, 7 & 8 and create a fund to develop umpires at the grass roots level. To give our members an opportunity to farewell Mary, a morning tea was organised in May and her daughter from Victoria attended. It was a wonderful morning, with many stories being shared among the 100+ people from many clubs who attended. A special thanks to Dr Wendy Hughes for attending and Nola Slade for her assistance with co-ordinating the event.

I would like to thank the many volunteers at club and association level. Our association cannot survive without you, from the smallest task to the large roles all are important. To everyone who umpired a game, brought in a corner flag, picked up a piece of rubbish – thank you, every job you did made one less job "someone" else had to do. This year a young lady from Kedron Wavell – Anna Mehonoshen won the opportunity of a life time to be a young volunteer ambassador for Hockey Australia at the World Cup. Anna travelled to Germany to represent Australia where she acquitted herself very well. While recognition of some volunteers does happen, for most it is a labour of love and commitment. It is difficult to single out individuals who work hard for hockey as we have so many great volunteers, but it must be said that BWA is indeed fortunate to have Dr Karin Walduck as President. Her knowledge, passion and good sense of

humour keeps us all on track and striving to achieve the best outcomes for the sport we all love. Thank you Karin for your continued enthusiasm. Congratulations also to our latest Life Member, Cheryl Kann. Cheryl has worked tirelessly for BWA for over 20 years, primarily in Umpire and Technical Development but also with Management and tournaments. Cheryl was welcomed as a Life Member at our 2009 Annual General Meeting.

Many of our members feel the joy of childbirth, engagements and marriages during the year and we congratulate you on these. On the other hand we also lose many loved ones or experience great loss for many reasons our condolences and thoughts go to all members who have suffered in this way.

BWA continues to grow and time becomes more precious. I cannot thank enough the people who continue to give so much time to our Association on a volunteer basis. Thank you to all our Management, Committees and Officials this year your support has been appreciated you can be justly proud of your achievements.

2010 has been a very busy year for our turf clubs. The mix of the State Hockey Centre, Redcliffe, Burringbar Park and the new Tiger Turf - Eastern Suburbs Hockey fields at Carina has had clubs playing at multiple venues this year.

A decision was made to make all turf divisions into 10 team competitions which totalled 50 turf teams an increase of two from 2009.

The turf season commenced in early March, ten timeslots were required for Division 1 and 2 on Saturdays with fifteen on Sundays needed for Division 3, 4 and 5 games.



Each Saturday and Sunday games were played at SHC, Burringbar Park, Redcliffe and Easts Hockey Turf on a rotating basis in conjunction with BHA to utilise as much turf time as possible.

### **MONDAY MASTERS**

Monday Masters competition was made up of 21 teams in total. Having three divisions meant that each division played at a separate venue each week, State Hockey Centre, Redcliffe, Burringbar Park and Easts Hockey Tiger Turf with the MM division 2 which had eight teams split each week. All teams recorded wins and all divisions were hotly contested. All finals were played at State Hockey Centre and the results are in the records section of this report.

### **DOWNEY PARK – GRASS**

This year a decision was made to try and equal the divisions and in the end 50 teams affiliated for Downey Park grass divisions, so five divisions of 10 were made up. Some teams struggled in the higher division but on the whole the competition was strongly contested each Saturday.

Presidents Cup was not held this year due to the large number of Inter-City, National and International games held during the season. The teams leading at the end of Round 1 were named the President's Cup winners.

With 121 teams in our competition this year, six up on 2009, 8 teams were Minor Premiers and Premiers in their division. All divisions were hotly contested with no team recording zero points.

Thank you to all the ladies who were on the BWA Fixture & Grading Committees for a job well done. Hope to see you back next year.

### **COMPETITION: OPERATIONS**

#### **UMPIRES REPORT:**

This year the U&TC met regularly throughout the season to streamline procedures and improve umpiring in the BWA competition. The committee implemented a parallel local umpiring pathway for umpires not wishing to undertake the expensive HockeyEd program.

Without umpires there wouldn't be any games, so there are many people to thank who contributed to the smooth running of the competition. Firstly thanks go to Kath Proctor for coordinating the allocation of Div 1 & Div 2 umpires, Sonya Fisher for allocating the Div 3- Div 5 umpires and Robyn Sutherland who allocated the grass umpires. These 3 people were responsible for finding approx 100 umpires every weekend which is a mammoth task. Thanks also to the many responsible umpires who turned up week after week to ensure that all the games could go ahead. This year BWA was tough on umpires who did not appear for their allocation. With umpire allocations available on the website the information was readily accessible. While the extra revenue from fines is always appreciated it is preferable that the umpire turns up as it is often a problem locating a replacement at short notice particularly for the first time slot at both turf and grass venues.

BWA fulfilled its obligations to HQ by sending umpires to the following state competitions: Open/Premier League (Townsville), U13s (Atherton), U15s (Tweed Border), Vets (Warwick) and U18s (Brisbane). While the umpires are unable to receive badges at these tournaments, they are assessed for their practical and are encouraged to then do the theory online.

A full technical bench of 3 qualified personnel was supplied at all QCTV games. Thank you to Ronda Nix for coordinating this. For all other games clubs were asked to supply an additional person to cover the BWA position. Thank you to clubs for fulfilling this additional task. An initiative this year in Masters was to roster clubs to provide technical support on games. We were fortunate to have Jenny Tidey, Helen Hill, Lyn Thomas and Ronda Nix as mentors.

Lastly thank you to the Umpiring and Technical Committee for their support throughout the season.

This year Masters was expanded to 21 teams over 3 divisions. The competition in all divisions was very close. With 4 venues available and some clubs with a team in each division the committee was able to arrange fixtures to enhance social interaction by arranging club nights. Thank you to Jane Hayes, Lesley Bennett, Robyn Andersen and Jenny Heron who made up the fixtures and grading committee.

For the first time a Masters committee was formed to oversee the interests of Masters Players in all BWA competitions. This was chaired by Ros Julien, ably assisted by Mary McNeill, Jenny Heron, Robyn Anderson, Pam Nichol, Robyn Sutherland and Lesley Bennett. Thank you to clubs for providing the name of a Masters Coordinator to facilitate the dispersal of information and to target correspondence from BWA to the relevant players. Thank you also to the committee for their tireless work to promote the interests of Masters Players.

A person from one of the competing clubs was named as the “BWA Official” to complete the BWA Judges Report and another two persons (one from each of the competing clubs) were required to sit on the technical bench to fill in the match details on their club scorebook. Some neutral volunteers officiated at some of the Masters fixtures. Qualified technical officials were appointed only to televised BWA club fixtures, and to semi-finals, preliminary finals and grand finals. Short technical talks to explain the various BWA forms and the contents and location of the technical kits at the various turf venues were given before the Rules Talks on Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> March by Ronda Nix and Cheryl Kann respectively. To assist club personnel to better understand what was expected of them in their roles as BWA technical officials supervising club fixtures, two Level “O” Brisbane Technical Certificate courses, presented by Ronda Nix, were held at the Downey Park clubhouse on 13<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> May 2010.

The BWA technical personnel who officiated on the televised games at various times during the season were: Lyn Thomas, Ronda Nix, Cheryl Kann, Caroline Schomberg, Jenny Heron, Sonya Fisher, John Luff, Ray Long and Kev Groenhuijzen.

**COMPETITIONS: RECORDING & REPORTING (MATCH SECRETARY REPORT)**

Clubs assisted by inserting team information into spreadsheets and sending this to the office. This information was able to be easily manipulated to check, count and record the details that BWA needs to work within its rules.

Unfortunately the reports we needed from SportingPulse we did not receive and so manual checking again was needed.

After setting up all the Senior Spreadsheets, Karen Hickling resigned to follow other pursuits. Michelle Slater offered to take over the position and tried to keep all our records up to date. With clubs constantly changing team personnel this is no easy task. My thanks to both Karen and Michele for their efforts in this area in 2010.

We are still trying to utilise the database in the best way possible to try to reduce the workload of our volunteers at BWHA and in clubs. This is a continuing process.

### **COMPETITIONS: SPORTS TRAINERS**

This was my first year on Management, I was allocated the task of looking after the Sports Trainers. The sports trainers for the past few years sat between competitions and technical and were identified as an area that may be able to be improved. I was charged in my first year to look at the processes and practices to ensure adequate coverage could be maintained and if necessary improved on.

In this role I contacted the Sports Trainers to ensure they were aware of our requirements and to address any concerns they may have had. During this process it was decided to provide eskies at the Downey Park First Aid Room and on the SHC 2 Tech Bench. This would allow timely availability of ice when the sports trainers on duty were attending to other injuries or away from their normal stations. Communications between the benches at SHC proved difficult at times, a request was made to SHC for the intercom to be repaired to allow easier contact when a trainer was required, to date it has not been actioned and will be pursued again next year.

It has also been identified that a covered area in a more accessible location would be beneficial at the SHC for the sports trainers use, it will also require a form of communication between this area and the two Tech Benches. BWHA have been in discussions with BHA and SHC regarding this and we hope to have a solution for 2011.

Overall I feel the sports trainers portfolio ran fairly smoothly this year barring the odd hiccup and I would like to congratulate them on a job well done. I would also like to thank the members of management who assisted me throughout the year. It has been an exciting year and I have enjoyed being on Management and being involved in the processes that run BWHA.

### **DATABASE REPORT – SPORTING PULSE**

This year BWHA employed Chris Carr, as our Data Entry person. Clubs only had to enter/activate every player in their Club, before they took the field to ensure all records were up to date. Sounds easy but it wasn't for some Clubs who do not realise the importance of the accurate use of this database information – the delay would mean match results could not be entered so points tables could not be kept up to date on a weekly basis. Also, every Club's Data Entry Person must complete all fields including addresses and contact details as we often require this information in here (especially in rep season).

Clubs were advised which players were missing on a weekly basis and if they had to be reminded a second or third time, fines were issued. The delay in entering a player (unintentional sometimes) meant Chris had to often try to enter match results (which is a long process if one player is missing) on several occasions. Clubs must also be aware that Clearances are of high importance and must be submitted prior to a player taking the field. Next year fines will be issued on a weekly basis until it is received in the office.

The database itself is still not “user friendly” for us in here – I have raised many issues with Sporting Pulse in Melbourne most could be fixed some could not. Reports are one very grey area which must be address in the near future or BWHA should look elsewhere for information we require.

So a huge thank you to Chris Carr for all her efforts this year and I hope next year will run more smoothly.

### REGIONAL COACHING DIRECTOR (RCD)

It was pleasing that after the last 2 years of disruption due to flooding that this year we were able to get through the season without any major interruptions. - BWA competed once again in the International Schools Southern Skies Tournament held in July. The team were a creditable runners-up and thank-you to Leon and Sue Cross for coaching

and managing the team. BWA has participated in this tournament since its inception in 1990 and after a very successful 10 years sadly will not be held in 2011. The tournament has provided our players over the years with a unique cultural and sporting exchange.

- Parent Information sessions were conducted prior to our U13 and U15 teams participation in their respective championships held in June/July school holidays. This was possible due to a successful funding application from Brisbane City Council. Various sports specialists provided lectures to all parents on areas of Nutrition, Sports Psychology, Sports Physiologist and Hockey Rules interpretation. This was very successful and Downey Park clubhouse was filled to the “brim” with over 80 parents participating. The information provided is being used to produce a “Representative Booklet” for future representative teams.
- Specialist Goalkeeping coaching during U11 Development and Selection Program.
- Coaching workshops were conducted in May/August for Beginner Coaches and Development Coach. 30 coaches participated.
- BWA hosted successful U18 championships in September with Brisbane fielding 3 teams.
- 2 x Hockey Queensland Coaching Conferences held in December 2009 and August 2010 both in conjunction with Men’s Champions Trophy in Melbourne and AHL finals week in Brisbane.
- BWA have entered teams into the Brisbane Indoor Hockey Competition in Division 1 and 2 teams plus 3 teams in the inaugural Hockey Queensland Team Challenge U18 and U15 competition. Congratulations to our U18 team who took out the final against Rockhampton.

In addition to these programs Regina Fisher Development Officer has been responsible for overseeing our Participation programs e.g. Active After School Programs, HookN2Hockey, Hockey in the Park, and many school development programs. Regie has also been responsible for our successful Rookey U7, U9 competition, U7 & U9 skills day and U11 programs.

There are many activities and development opportunities planned during 2011 with several new joint initiatives with Brisbane Men’s Hockey Association

## UMPIRES PORTFOLIO REPORT

### TURF UMPIRES' STEWARD REPORT

In 2010, Jan Hadfield assisted Kathy Proctor in respect to Div 1 - 2 allocations and I allocated umpires to Div 3 – 5. The allocations were again made more difficult (particularly on Div 3 - 5 fixtures) due to the use of three venues some Sundays.

Thanks to our regular international umpire, Lynn Cowie-McAllister, who umpired most fixture weekends when she wasn't away umpiring at an International tournament or test series. Having Lynn available on one end of our top Div 1 games, provides a depth of knowledge that is invaluable – both to the teams and to other less experienced Div 1 umpires.

Many of our top level umpires and former umpires, again attended International, National and State Championships in 2010 – as umpires, umpire managers and umpire coaches.

BWHA still has a very good group of senior umpires who can cover Div 1-2 fixtures. However, with most clubs still trying to increase their numbers of experienced turf umpires, we often have to allocate less experienced umpires to Div 3 – 5 games – both to support our clubs who are trying to ensure that their players umpire and also sometimes just to fill holes in the allocations.

To the club umpires who turn up every week (sometimes for 2-3 games) – well done!! Our competition could not run without you.

To the players – when your club officials ask you to umpire, think about why you should say “yes” rather than “no” – think about what the sport of hockey has given to you and what you can give back in return. I was asked this year why we're not able to look at more of the umpires who nominated for field testing on turf fixtures. With a very limited pool of mentors, we are just unable to do it. We would recommend that if you have umpires interested in being tested, that you ask them to nominate for one (or more) of the State Championships that are held throughout the year (from June through to Sept). That way they will receive intensive mentoring and hopefully a step-up in their HockeyEd accreditation.

### GRASS UMPIRES STEWARD'S REPORT

During 2010, Senior Clubs at Downey Park were again required to submit a Register of Umpires which could be used to allocate at least one suitable umpire to a game corresponding to each team that they had registered in divisions DP1-5. Most clubs were diligent in providing this Register in the initial stages, however, many limits and over-riders developed that created many variations to the actual placement of the umpires on a week to week basis.

Variations and limits included

- Providing only two or three umpires to be allocated to DP1 and DP2
- Listing Turf players, from divisions playing on Saturday, to be allocated to DP1 and 2 requesting players be allocated, in turn, from Team sheets with no information about their experience
- Combining badged umpires, team rosters and/or paid umpires sourced from other clubs
- Limiting registers to list one umpire per team
- Providing a short list accompanied by a large number of unavailable dates
- Submitting a limited register as a front to the club's system
- Not providing a Register at all

It would be fair to say that although they may submit the Grass Umpires Register, each club has, in the background, their own individual methods for

- Providing the number of umpires equal to the number of games that the club is playing on the day
- Satisfying the requirement for umpires on higher grades to be appropriately badged
- Developing new umpires and creating a positive experience for them
- Ensuring that all players share the task of officiating
- Upholding the responsibility to provide quality umpires to others, in the name of fair play

Some clubs combine this well with the 'system' and some have failings which create difficulties for us all. Many Clubs would make adjustments or requests for changes which, depending upon the success of their background systems may or may not have achieved timely, favourable results. The process of Umpire Allocations became a work in progress, every week, sometimes right up to the starting hooter.

- Many substitutions were made after the draw was posted
- Much time was then spent by Office staff in posting individual changes to the website
- Often umpires were substituted without notice so the umpire named was not the umpire present
- Frequently umpires were late or failed to show
- Often complaints were received about the quality of umpires
- Some umpires were overworked
- A large number of beginner umpires took the field without a mentor
- Clubs with low compliance were often the loudest to complain about their allocations and/or other umpires on their games

Whatever means they used, though, it is pleasing that clubs generally took care to ensure that they satisfied their obligation to field the appropriate number of suitable umpires, in the right place at the right time. The point to bear in mind is - how to do this more time efficiently, with less last minute panic and with minimal absenteeism. Simply - submit the Grass Register as early as possible and ensure all players who are on the register are informed as early as possible about their allocations.

Congratulations and thank you to

- All umpires who carried out their allocations. Especially those who umpire every week
- The good number of umpires who were successful in receiving their badge. Well done
- All clubs who submit their registers and have minimal adjustments to make. Much appreciated
- All clubs who are working hard to increase their pool of umpires and make every effort to make sure that their beginner umpires are supported
- All teams who play in good spirits and ensure that umpiring your team is a pleasant experience
