



HOCKEY QUEENSLAND VACCINE REQUIREMENT

On December 17 2021, the Queensland Government is set to ease restrictions for entry to Queensland. From this date there will be new border and travel requirements in place and many Queensland locations and businesses will have eased restrictions for vaccinated patrons.

In line with the Government's plan, Hockey Queensland will require proof of vaccination for some activities. Please see below for some Frequently Asked Questions in relation to the HQ vaccination plan.

FAQ's

Who is required to be vaccinated?

Anyone who wishes to volunteer for a Hockey Queensland appointed position will be required to accept the terms and conditions of taking on that position, which includes to be double vaccinated. State Team Participants over the age of 16 are also required to accept the terms and conditions of their selection including to be double vaccinated.

How do you provide proof of your vaccine status?

You will be required to upload your evidence to Revolutionise Sport via the link we send you.

Proof of your vaccination can be:

- a [COVID-19 digital certificate](#);
- your [immunisation history statement](#); (for those who have only had one dose)
- An [International COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate](#) for overseas travel.

What if you have an exemption?

If you're unable to be vaccinated for COVID-19 due to a medical contraindication, you'll need to provide evidence of this to Hockey Queensland.

You'll need a medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner stating the medical contraindication. If your medical contraindication is temporary, your medical certificate will also need to state the time period it applies for, and you'll need a new medical certificate if your contraindication continues beyond that date.

If you are not vaccinated because of medical contraindication, you can continue to volunteer, but you must wear a mask when indoors or where you can't socially distance.



Why is Hockey Queensland requiring volunteers to be vaccinated?

Hockey Queensland has a duty of care to keep our volunteers safe. The new condition of double vaccination before being appointed to a position also provides logistical support for Hockey Queensland to manage travel bookings or other vaccine mandates that we will intersect with, such as when events take place at schools.

Why are State Team players over the age of 16 required to be vaccinated?

Hockey Queensland has a duty of care to keep our teams safe when travelling. The new condition of double vaccination before being selected to the team also assists in ensuring the team can attend venues and travel together.

Why are those under 16 only strongly recommended to be vaccinated and not required to be?

Hockey Queensland has aligned with the State and National requirements of vaccine requirements for those over the age of 16. Many of the restrictions that will inhibit teams are for those over 16.

Will this information change?

More than likely! As we have found all through the pandemic restrictions and Government plans change along with the health advice. The Hockey Queensland Plan is subject to change as information comes to hand. We will endeavour to provide plenty of notice to our community when things do change.
