Area	#	Description
Volunteer Manager	1	Volunteer Management The volunteer supervisor will be responsible for coordinating all volunteers, including availability, supervision, and rostering.
Ball patrol Supervisor	1	Manage Ball Patrol persons The Ball Patrol Supervisor will be responsible for coordinating all Ball Patrol persons, including induction, supervision and rostering.
Gate 1 – Gate Attendants	3	<i>Ticket Scanning (pre-paid tickets)</i> Volunteers will sell match day tickets from the box office at the entrance and ensure all tickets and accreditations are scanned/checked before spectators enter the grounds.
Memberships & Merchandise	1	<i>Distribution of membership packages / Merchandise</i> The volunteer will manage the hand-out of membership packages to members who have pre-purchased a membership and assist with the sale of merchandise items.
The Inferno (Welcome/Access Control)	1	<i>Meet & Greet VIPs</i> Welcome all VIPs entering the Platinum Precinct. VIPs to present their VIP pass to volunteer - upon presentation of valid VIP pass, volunteer to provide a wristband.
The Inferno (Hospitality)	2	<i>Manage Hospitality for Platinum Precinct</i> Volunteers will assist with the service of drinks upon arrival & service of canapes (5-6 pm & 7.15-8 pm) and ensure the area is maintained tidy. Volunteers will be directed and supported by HQ staff.
Grandstand (Access Control)	2	<i>Grandstand Access (VIPs, Players & Player Family)</i> Volunteers will control access to the grandstand, which is only permitted to people possessing relevant accreditation.
Roamers	2	<i>Assistance for all Volunteers & Venue Areas</i> Volunteers will walk around the venue providing short breaks to any volunteer as required and monitor toilets/bins & courtyard areas for cleanliness.
Bar Personnel	3	<i>Assist a staff member on the car bar locations</i> Volunteers will assist the bar staff (RSA certificate required).
Spectator Services	4	<i>Spectator Entertainment</i> Volunteers will assist in the set-up & operation of the pre-match entertainment, player signings and any further planned activations.
Mascot Assistant	1	<i>Spectator entertainment with the Brisbane Blaze Mascot</i> One volunteer will assist in guiding the Blaze mascot and engage with spectators.
Kid's zone	2	<i>Supervise kid's activities</i> Supervise the designated kid's zone and organise activities, including hit the target hockey, colouring in, yard games.
